

CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH IS GETTING A \$1.05 MILLION BOOST THANKS TO AUSTRALIAN LIONS CHILDHOOD CANCER RESEARCH FOUNDATION

- *Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation is providing \$1.05 million to support Telethon Kids Institute's leading research*
- *Funding to enable vital research into cancer immunotherapy to improve survival rates, longevity and quality of life for children with cancer*
- *Over the past 10 years, the Australian Lions Childhood Research Foundation has raised over \$10 million for childhood cancer research*

Wednesday December 11th: Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation has announced it will provide \$1.05 million of funding to the Telethon Kids Institute.

The funding will support the Telethon Kids Cancer Centre's vital research aimed at improving survival rates, longevity and quality of life for children with cancer.

"At Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation we believe every child deserves a chance at a healthy life," Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation Chairperson John Thorpe said. "We are very proud to be providing \$1.05 million worth of funding to Telethon Kids."

Chair of the Telethon Kids Institute, the Hon. Julie Bishop, said they are excited to be partnering with such a well-respected, community-oriented organisation like Lions Australia.

"We are so grateful for Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation's support," Ms Bishop said. "This \$1.05 million in funding will enable the Telethon Kids Cancer Centre to continue its leading research into childhood cancer - particularly in the area of cancer immunotherapy, which focuses on supercharging the body's natural defences to destroy cancer cells."

Mr Thorpe described cancer immunotherapy as one of the most exciting and promising cancer treatments being developed, particularly for childhood cancer.

"It is our hope that this work will benefit kids all over Australia and beyond," he said. "More than 800 children aged 0-14 years are diagnosed with cancer in Australia each year. Many of these cancers are aggressive and hard to treat and we are losing too many young lives."

"Although survival rates have improved greatly for some, most cancers take a toll on young people's lives and often side effects of treatment can be serious and lifelong."

"Telethon Kids Cancer Centre's research into cancer immunotherapy is focused on finding ways to help these children's immune systems fight cancer cells. This will be revolutionary in the treatment of childhood cancer."

Professor Terrance Johns, Head of the Telethon Kids Cancer Centre, said that as one of Australia's only comprehensive, paediatric cancer immunotherapy centre, the Telethon Kids Cancer Centre was making its mark on medical research.

"The Centre is on a mission to prevent paediatric disease and improve the wellbeing of children with cancer. We bring together leading researchers and oncologists focused on developing therapies that destroy cancer cells, while minimising the side effects to children's short- and long-term health," Professor Johns said.

The \$1.05 million of funding to Telethon Kids Institute builds on the Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation's long history in supporting leading and innovative research into childhood cancer.

Dear Fellow Lions,
As a fundraiser for **Australian Lions Childhood Cancer Research Foundation**, we are attempting to break the record for the **Longest Coin Line** in the **Guinness Book of Records**. This attempt is being coordinated by the Lions Club of Elmore Vale in District N3 for ALCCRF in November 2020.

We call on all Lions Clubs to contact their local schools personally and request them to hold a coin line during the month of September **Childhood Cancer Awareness Month**. We envisage each child will bring coins to lay down in a line and would encourage staff and parents to do likewise. The school is then welcome and encouraged to take a picture of the line and their students and post it on the "**Australian Lions Longest Coin Line**" Facebook or Twitter or Instagram #LionsCoinLine pages set up for this challenge.

We are hoping that community members will also hold their own coin line. It is an easy project and a lot of fun. It raises the profile of Lions Clubs and publicises the wide range of work of Lions. It also provides a great photo opportunity for your local media.

Lions Clubs are requested to collect the money from their participating schools, staff, parents and students, then deposit it in the ALCCRF bank account.

The organisers will then convert the funds to 5c pieces. They will be laid out in accordance with Guinness World Record Rules. The schools we have approached so far have been very keen to get involved because, as you would expect, every school has been affected in some way by childhood cancer. Recently a two-hour collection at the Newcastle Supercars Race raised \$1409, which demonstrates just how willing people are to contribute to this cause.

It is anticipated that this could become an annual event, to be held in conjunction with Childhood Cancer Awareness Month in September each year. Lions will break the record sooner or later, and will no doubt continue to lift the bar. In that way young Australian Cancer sufferers will benefit accordingly each year.

Your club may already donate to ALCCRF via one of the other project ideas. We thank you for your help. If not, maybe this is a project that your club would like to help us with. We only need approximately 76 km of coins to break the record! Last year, in a little over 6 weeks we were able to raise enough money to lay 10 km of coins. We are pacing ourselves this time by launching the attempt in September 2019 and laying the coins in November 2020.
